The Dyslexia Association provides the following services & support for dyslexics of all ages, their families, educators, employers & the wider community:

- **Dyslexia Helpline:** Providing free confidential information & advice: **0115 924 6888 / www.dyslexia.uk.net**
- **Advice Service:** Providing confidential one to one advice appointments for parents concerned about their dyslexic child, for adults concerned about the difficulties dyslexia is causing them at work, in learning or at home.
- **Professional Consultancy Service:** For employers & educators who want more in depth professional advice/guidance to support a dyslexic employee or learner. 1-2 hrs, includes written report.
- **Dyslexia Screening:** Identifying indicators of dyslexia warranting further assessment.
 - **Children** – aged 5yrs to 16yrs. NFER Dyslexia Screener includes Advice Session with Dyslexia Specialist.
 - **Adults** –LADS Plus includes Advice Session with Dyslexia Specialist.
 - **Adults** – QuickScan on-Line Dyslexia Screener.
- **Diagnostic Dyslexia Assessment:** Identifying strengths & weaknesses. Includes a detailed report with recommendations for support in learning or the workplace as appropriate.
 - **Children** – aged 6yrs to 16yrs.
 - **Adults** – aged 16+.
- **One to One Specialist Dyslexia Tuition:** We work with children from age six & adult learners across all ability levels, from basic skills to post-graduate level. Tuition is tailored to meet the needs & aims of each individual.
 - Children and Adults one to one Tuition.
 - Disabled Students Allowance Support.
 - Access to Work Support.
- **Assistive Technology:** There is now a wide range of assistive technology to help dyslexics overcome some of their reading, spelling, writing, memory & organisational difficulties. Available products include Text to Speech, Voice Recognition, Mind Mapping, Study Skills software & much more. We provide information, advice & training on suitable packages.
 - One to one Advice Session with demonstrations and written report, 2 hrs.
 - One to one Training Sessions.
 - Demonstrations for groups of 4-6 people, 3 hrs.
- **Visual Stress Test:** Quite often people have problems with excessive glare when reading black print a white background. These problems can sometimes be alleviated by using coloured overlays, coloured paper or even wearing glasses with tinted lenses. The VST has been designed to follow the scientific research behind this condition.
- **Touch-Type Read & Spell:** A multi-sensory computer based programme to teach keyboard skills, whilst improving learners' reading, writing & spelling skills. Suitable from 7 years of age to adult. Home/Work licences for adults also available.
- **Dyslexia Training:** One of our aims is to raise awareness of dyslexia in the community, education & the workplace. We provide dyslexia awareness training tailored to meet the specific needs of each group.
