



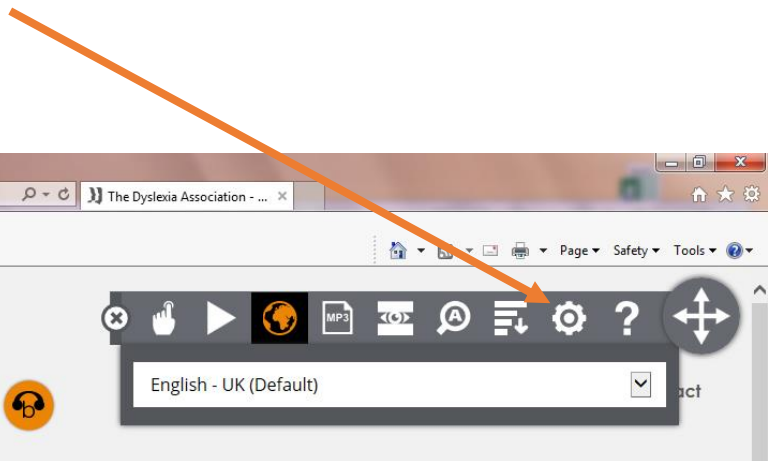
How to use BrowseAloud with a pdf document

1. Go to the top of The Dyslexia Association web page and click the BrowseAloud icon
